**WHEREAS,** Contractor wishes to assist the City by providing, furnishing, or performing such improvements and services;

Ratifies, confirms and approves that the City Manager, or his designee, of the City of Mansfield, Texas is authorized to enter into the contract for management and improvement services with FirstService Residential in the form as set forth attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.
