

RESOLUTION NO. _____**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS ON MAY 4, 2019, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR, PLACE 1; AND A COUNCIL MEMBER, PLACE 2**

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2019, the City Council of the City of Mansfield, Texas, (the “City Council”), duly called a general election to be held on May 4, 2019; and,

WHEREAS, the election returns of the ballots cast in said general election are hereby canvassed for the positions of Mayor, Place 1; and Council Member, Place 2; and

WHEREAS, after duly canvassing said returns from each precinct, the City Council finds that the total votes cast at said election for the candidates for said offices is as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1.

The City Council finds that the results of the general election as set forth above are true and correct.

SECTION 2.

A tabulation of the results for each election precinct within the City of Mansfield, Texas, for said election is attached as Exhibit “A” and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3.

The official returns shall be delivered to the City Secretary, who is hereby directed to enter into the election register the tabulations of the votes cast for each candidate to preserve such tabulations as required by law.

SECTION 4.

The notice of said election was duly and properly given as required by law, and that said elections were duly held and returns thereof were made by the proper officials of said elections and in all things according to law.

SECTION 5.

This resolution shall be effective from and after its passage.
