A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF CEDAR HILL FOR THE USE OF THE MANSFIELD ENVIRONMENTAL COLLECTION CENTER.

Whereas, the proper disposal of household hazardous wastes is a common goal of the City of Mansfield, Texas ("City") and the City of Cedar Hill, Texas ("Cedar Hill"); and

Whereas, the City and the Cedar Hill desire to enter into this Agreement for the access to the Mansfield Environmental Collection Center for disposal of household hazardous wastes by Cedar Hill residents; and

Whereas, it is deemed to be in the best interest of both the City and Cedar Hill that said parties do enter into a mutually satisfactory agreement by means of which Cedar Hill may obtain access to the Mansfield Environmental Collection Center; and

Whereas, the City and Cedar Hill have determined that the consideration granted herein is in the best interests of the parties as it is mutually beneficial to the citizens and taxpayers of both the City and Cedar Hill.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

The City of Mansfield, Texas does hereby agree to participate in an interlocal agreement for the purpose of providing access to the Mansfield Environmental Collection Center for residents of the City of Cedar Hill, Texas.

SECTION 2.

This resolution shall take effect from and after the date of passage.

SECTION 3.

The City Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Cedar Hill to provide access to the Mansfield Environmental Collection Center.
