A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH THE JOHNSON COUNTY ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATOR TO PERFORM ELECTION SERVICES FOR THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 GENERAL ELECTION AND SPECIAL ELECTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE
<b>WHEREAS,</b> Subchapter D of Chapter 31 of the Texas Election Code authorizes a county election officer to contract with the governing body of a municipality located wholly or partly in the county to perform election services; and,
<b>WHEREAS,</b> Subchapter A of Chapter 42 of the Texas Election Code requires the use of county election precincts for elections held by a political subdivision on a November uniform election date; and,
<b>WHEREAS,</b> a portion of the City of Mansfield is located in Johnson County; therefore, the Election Code requires election day polling places in each precinct in that particular county; and,
<b>WHEREAS</b> , the City Council of the City of Mansfield desires to have the Johnson County Elections Administrator conduct the November 3, 2020 General Election and Special Election to the extent permitted by law.
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, THAT:
SECTION 1.
The Joint Election Agreement with the Johnson County Elections Administrator and the City of Mansfield (the "Contract"), attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is hereby approved for all purposes and the Mayor is authorized to execute the Contract. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary to enable the Johnson County Elections Administrator and the City to conduct the November 3, 2020 General Election and Special Election in accordance with all applicable law.
SECTION 2.
This resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
