Discussion and Possible Action Regarding the Allocation Recommendations for FY 20/21 Hotel/Motel Tax Funds by the Hotel/Motel Tax Policy and Use Sub-Committee (Addendum to Agenda)

Sub-Committee Chairwoman Short thanked Council Members Newsom and Lewis for their hard work on the sub-committee as well as staff and the organizations who applied. Ordinance - First Reading of an Ordinance Considering Approval of an Ordinance Adopting the Budget for the Fiscal Year Beginning on October 1, 2020, and Ending on September 30, 2021, and Making Appropriations for Each Fund and Department

City Manager Joe Smolinski thanked the Council and staff for their involvement in the budget process.

A motion was made by Council Member Leyman to approve the first reading of "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE ENSUING FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2020 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2021, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, APPROPRIATING THE VARIOUS AMOUNTS THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE." Ordinance - First Reading of an Ordinance Levying the Ad Valorem Taxes for Fiscal Year 2021 at a Rate of \$0.69000 per One Hundred Dollars (\$100) Assessed Valuation on all Taxable Property

Joe Smolinski made brief comments. The Council, thanked Joe and city staff for their hard work on the budget, tax rate reduction, and a homestead exemption.

A motion was made by Council Member Newsom to approve the first reading of "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, LEVYING THE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 AT A RATE OF \$0.69000 PER ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) ASSESSED VALUATION ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY AS OF JANUARY 1, 2020, TO PROVIDE REVENUES FOR THE PAYMENT OF CURRENT

EXPENDITURES AND TO PROVIDE AN INTEREST AND SINKING FUND ON ALL OUTSTANDING DEBTS OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR DUE AND DELINQUENT DATES TOGETHER WITH PENALTIES AND INTEREST; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE." Seconded by Council Member Broseh. The motion CARRIED by the following vote:
