4. FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY UPDATE

Friends of MPL President Carol Ann Grantham provided the update:

- One of the Mansfield Reads! 2018 programs is the "Texas Cooking with a Twist" cooking class on April 19; the deadline to register is Friday, April 13, and there is space available (cost is \$50).
- The Mansfield Reads! 2018 "Meet the Author Luncheon" is on April 26; the deadline to register is April 20, and there is space available (cost is \$25).
- Just over 100 people have registered for "An Evening with the Author" on April 27.
- The library has copies of the On Texas Backroads book for \$10.
- The April calendar contains the additional Mansfield Reads! 2018 programming.
- Friends Officers and members, Carol Ann Grantham, Paula Hillfill, and Jenny Elliott attended the TLA Conference in Dallas April 3-6, 2018 and met some potential authors for Mansfield Reads! 2019.

5. DIRECTOR OF LIBRARY SERVICES REPORT

Library Update

Director of Library Services Yolanda Botello provided an update:

- National Library Week is April 8-14, 2018.
- The Mansfield Public Library earned the Achievement of Excellence in Libraries Award for 2017.
- The Q2 report was provided to City Council; the information included impressive statistics:

From 2012-2017, library programming has increased 381%. From 2012-2017, library program attendance has increased 195%.

- Ms. Botello and Ms. Faria Matin delivered two presentations at the TLA Conference in Dallas.
- The library will be closing at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, April 27 to prepare for the Mansfield Reads! 2018 "An Evening with the Author" event.

Budget Update

- Ms. Botello has turned in the library's mission, goals, objectives and budget request.
- A request for a new Community Engagement professional position was included in the request.
- Additionally, there is a request to increase pay for part-time employees.
- The full budget proposal is due on April 27.
- The budget review is on May 11 with the City Manager.
- A capital request for an outdoor book drop was submitted.

Library Policies Review

- Ms. Botello presented the second draft of the updated policies, which included updated titles, the addition of Kennedale Public Library, and updates in ages for computer usage.
- Board Members were asked to review the updated version and send any edits to Ms. Botello.
- Ms. Botello will add the City Ordinance and Challenged Materials Form in an Appendix. A Disaster Plan section will be added once the plan is complete.
- Ms. Botello will share a final draft of the policies next month.
