8:30 A.M. - CALL MEETING TO ORDER

WORK SESSION DISCUSSION ITEM

Discussion Regarding Potential City Charter Amendments

Interim City Manager Joe Smolinski made brief comments and turned it over to the Council for discussion. The Council discussed potential changes to the City Charter. Mayor Cook explained this would be a special election with voters deciding whether changes are made. City Secretary Susana Marin and City Attorney Allen Taylor answered Council questions. The Council discussed amending the following sections of the City Charter: Section 3.02 Qualifications; 3.06.(b) Mayor and Mayor Pro Tem; 3.09 Meetings and Procedures; 3.13 Ordinances in General; 6.01 City Manager; 6.03 City Secretary (add); 8.05 City Attorney; 9.15 Department of Taxation (delete); and 10.01 The Planning and Zoning Commission. The Council asked Mr. Taylor to provide wording to amend all sections of the City Charter where state law is contradictory to the Charter.

Mayor Cook recessed the meeting at 10:27 a.m. Mayor Cook reconvened the meeting at 10:36 p.m.

Discussion Regarding Historic Downtown Mansfield TIRZ No. 2

Joe Smolinski gave a brief update regarding the Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone No. 2. Director of Planning Matt Jones made a presentation and discussed the timeline of the TIRZ No. 2 projects, to date TIRZ expenditures, the adopted project plan from 2013, eligible projects, and potential TIRZ reimbursement. He stated the next steps would be to present reimbursement agreements to the TIRZ No. 2 Board of Directors for consideration and potentially amend the project plan if allocated funds needed to be updated. Assistant Director of Public Works David Boski answered Council questions regarding wayfinding improvements. Deputy City Manager Shelly Lanners gave an update on the downtown study. Staff was asked to place the downtown study presentation on the agenda for July, 13, 2020.

Discussion Regarding City Council Calendar

Joe Smolinski made brief comments regarding the City Council calendar and possible items to be discussed during upcoming meetings. There was Council interest in holding joint meetings with the Planning and Zoning Commission, Mansfield Park Facilities Development Corporation, and the Mansfield Economic Development Corporation.
