4. MAN HOUSE MUSEUM UPDATE

Terry Moore and David Cook offered to pay \$300 each toward moving the windmill from its current location. The money will be given to the Mansfield Heritage Foundation to hold and spend on the project. Neither of them had paid so far. James offered to remind them about it when he sees them tomorrow.

Jessica will contact the windmill moving company to get it on their schedule. She will also contact the landowner to update her and the city parks department to schedule a cleanup of the site.
