<u>22-4754</u> HLC#22-007: Public hearing continuation to consider a request for a Historic Landmark Overlay District designation for the Mansfield Cemetery, c. 1868, located at 750 W. Kimball Street; Paula McKay on behalf of the Mansfield Cemetery Association, owner

Mr. Wright updated the Commission on the progress of the case and reported that the Mansfield Community Cemetery Association responded positively to the invitation to join in a Historic Cemetery Landmark Overlay District.
