Resolution - A Proposed Resolution Awarding a One Year Renewable Contract to the Lowest and Best Bid for the Supply of One Ton Chlorine Cylinders, for an Amount not to Exceed \$770.00 / Wet Ton (Utility Fund FY-2018, FY-2019 Operating Budget)

Resolution authorizing a one year renewable option contract for the supply of one ton cylinders of chlorine.

City staff recommends approval of a resolution awarding the bid to the lowest and best bidder, DPC Industries, Inc., for the supply of one ton chlorine cylinders, for the amount of \$770.00 / wet ton.

The invitation to bid was advertised in the Fort Worth Star Telegram, posted on the City of Mansfield website, and bid packets were e-mailed to known suppliers and companies that requested them.

Chlorine in conjunction with sodium chlorite is generated on-site to make chlorine dioxide, which decreases the iron and manganese in the pretreated water.
