This Addendum, made by and between Emergicon, LLC and the City of Mansfield, Texas, is incorporated into and forms a part of the original Service Agreement, signed on January 21, 2008. If any section in this Addendum shall conflict with the Service Agreement, this Addendum shall supersede.

In consideration for Emergicon providing the agreed upon billing services, the City of Mansfield will pay Emergicon 18% of the total amount collected on the account if the account is older than 120 days from the date of service, and 8% of the total amount collected on the account if the account is less than 120 days from the date of service. All fees shall be payable monthly within 30 days of receipt of invoice.
