To protect the Taskforce Officers, we request permission to spend \$57,000.00 from the Taskforce program income for new Motorola radios. These radios can switch to cellular service when regular radio service is no longer working. New radios will allow Taskforce officers to contact dispatch at all times, no matter where they are in the county.
