City Council to approve an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Arlington for the purpose of cooperative purchase of goods, products, and/or services.

Staff recommends approval of the Interlocal Agreement.

The City of Mansfield and the City of Arlington wish to enter into this agreement pursuant to Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, which is referred to as the Interlocal Cooperation Act. The standard agreement sets forth the terms and conditions upon which the City of Mansfield and the City of Arlington may purchase various goods and services commonly utilized by each party.

Participation in an interlocal agreement will be highly beneficial to the taxpayers of the City of Mansfield through the anticipated savings to be realized and is of mutual concern to the contracting parties.
