Resolution - A Resolution of the City of Mansfield, Texas, Calling for a General Election to be Held on May 6, 2017; Designating Polling Places; Establishing Election Precincts Within the City; Appointing an Election Judge and Alternate Judge; Establishing Other Procedures for Conduct of the Election; Establishing a Date for Canvassing Returns; Establishing a Date for Runoff Election, if Necessary; and Providing an Effective Date

Approval of the Resolution Calling the May 6, 2017 General Election for the City of Mansfield.

City staff recommends the City Council order the General election to be held May 6, 2017 and June Runoff Election, if necessary, by approving the resolution outlining the election procedures.

Pursuant to Section 41.001 of the Texas Election Code and the Home Rule Charter, the City is required to conduct its general election on the first Saturday in May. The following positions are scheduled to be on the May 2017 ballot: Council Member Place 6; Council Member Place 7.

The City Secretary's Office is distributing candidate packets upon request.

The General Election is to be held in accordance with the Home Rule Charter and State law.

Funds are allocated in the City Council budget (001-8806-11-01) for this expenditure.
