Resolution - A Resolution Amending the Bylaws for the Historic Preservation Advisory Board to Establish a Policy Regarding Consecutive Years of Service

Approve a Resolution to Amend the Bylaws for the Historic Preservation Advisory Board

Approve Resolution

The City Council authorized the City Manager to make changes beginning January 1, 2022 to establish a policy regarding consecutive years of service. Directors may serve up to three consecutive terms for a total of six years unless the change causes an excess of 25% of the board or commission to turn over, then the most senior members in time would terminate and that a term member can reapply after a break from that board or commission that is equal to or no less than twelve months. This change is being made to give others in a growing community an opportunity to serve and to encourage those that have served for multiple, consecutive terms opportunities to serve in different capacities. In addition, the Bylaws are being updated to reflect a change from eight (8) members to serve in (7) members. The proposed amendments were approved at the November 2022 Historic Preservation Advisory board meeting.

The amendments to the Bylaws will coincide with the direction from City Council
